1- Acquis

Consedering *acquis* as obligations that all the EU member states have to apply. Therefore, they have to accept the *acquis* before they can join the EU.

Some chapter of acquis:

- Freedom of movement of workers, financial services, agriculture and rural development, judiciary and fundamental rights, justice, freedom and security...

Human rights as "the right to life and liberty, freedom from slavery and torture, freedom of opinion and expression, the right to work and education, and many more."

2- How human rights are important for the EU?

Human rights includes:

- Freedom, democracy, equality, the rule of law (EU Charter of Fundamental Rights consisting of European Convention on Human Rights)
- Luropean Court of Justice (ECJ) which enables you to apply for Individuals seeking redress
- Fundamental Rights Agency: established in 2007 as an EU Agency with the specific task of providing independent, evidence-based advice on fundamental rights.
- Organization that was awarded a far broader mandate to provide this task in line with the <u>EU</u>
 <u>Charter of Fundamental Rights.</u>

Policies: Rights of women, minorities and children, Cultural and social rights, Being opposed to the death penalty, discrimination and torture, Political and economic rights




