# 1- Acquis

Considering *acquis* as obligations that all the EU member states have to apply. Therefore, they have to accept the *acquis* before they can join the EU.

## Some chapter of *acquis*:

- *Freedom of movement of workers, financial services, agriculture and rural development, **judiciary and fundamental rights, justice, freedom and security...***

**Human rights** as “the right to life and liberty, freedom from slavery and torture, freedom of opinion and expression, the right to work and education, and many more.”

## 2- How human rights are important for the EU?

Human rights includes:

- ❖ Freedom, democracy, equality, the rule of law (EU Charter of Fundamental Rights consisting of European Convention on Human Rights )
- ❖ [European Court of Justice \(ECJ\)](#) which enables you to apply for Individuals seeking redress
- ❖ [Fundamental Rights Agency](#): established in 2007 as an EU Agency with the specific task of providing independent, evidence-based advice on fundamental rights.
- Organization that was awarded a far broader mandate to provide this task in line with the [EU Charter of Fundamental Rights](#).

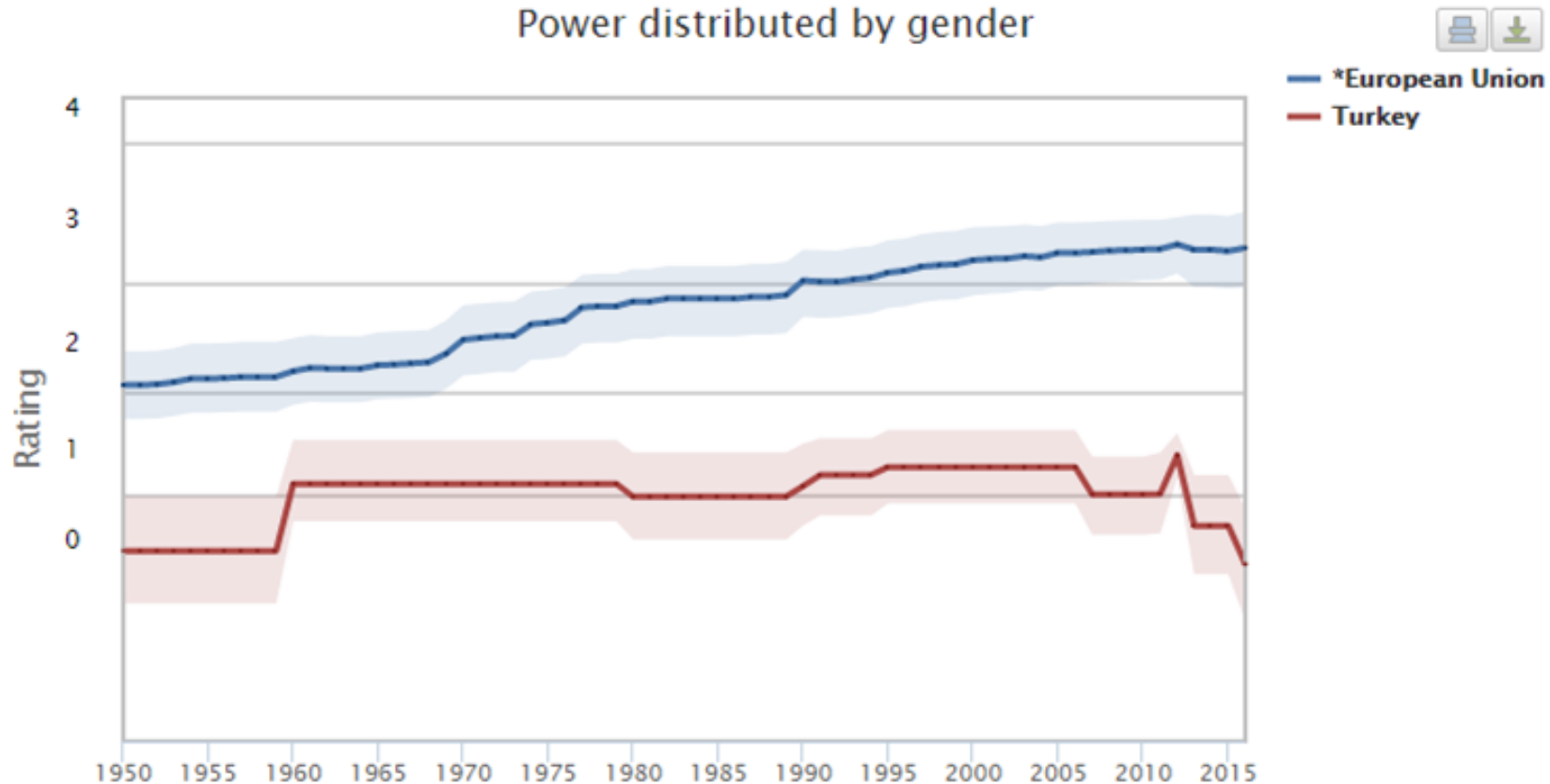
**Policies:** *Rights of women, minorities and children, Cultural and social rights, Being opposed to the death penalty, discrimination and torture, Political and economic rights*

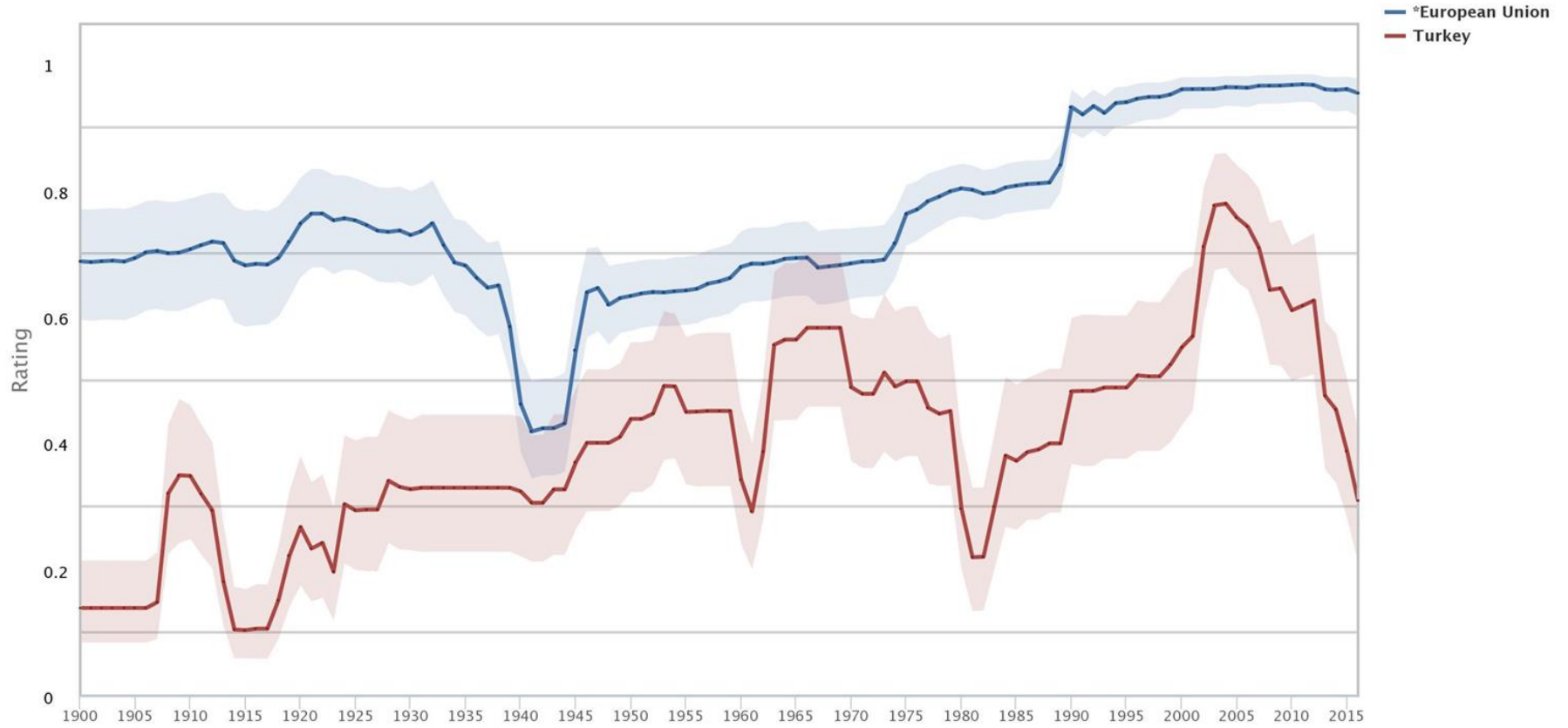

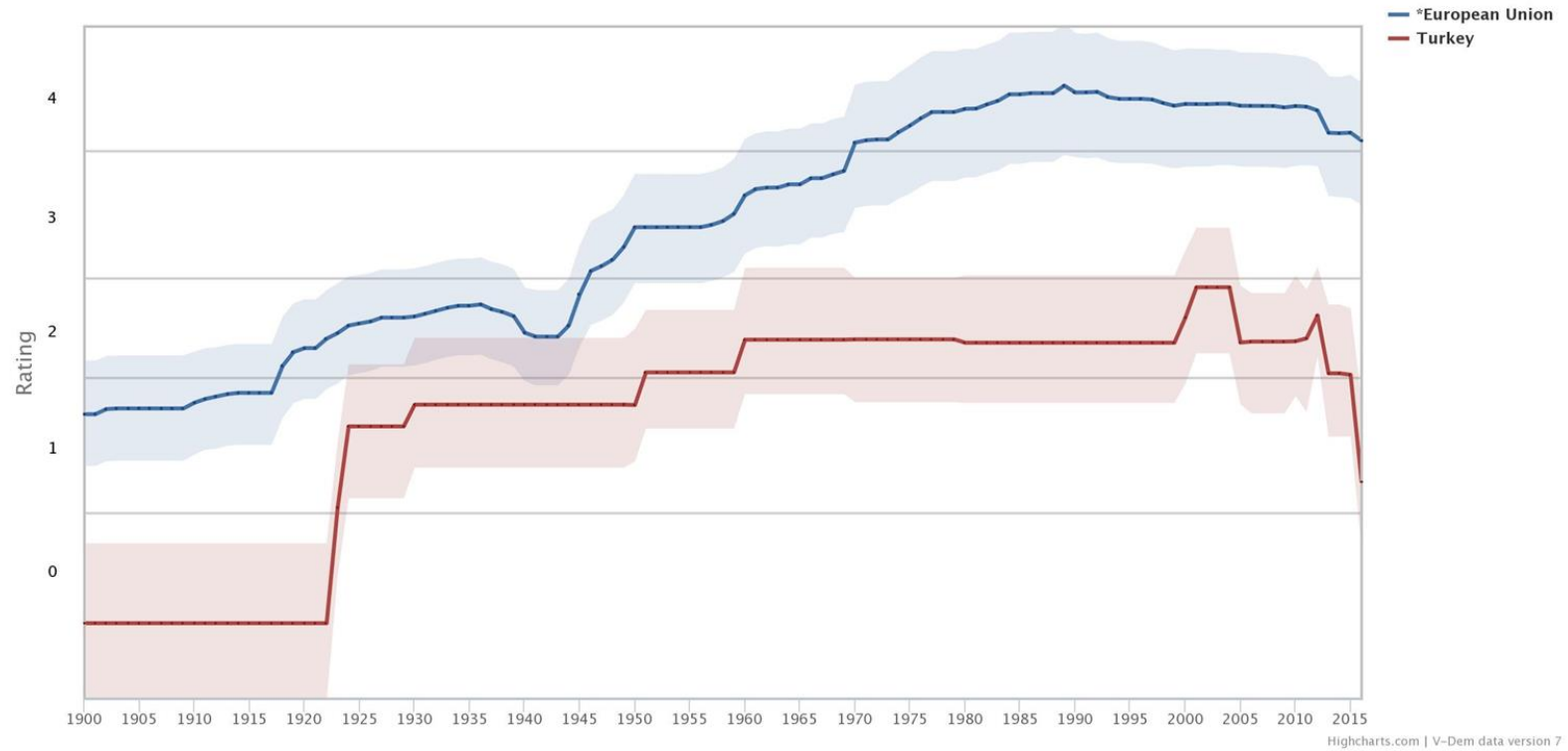
## Power distributed by gender



## Equality before the law and individual liberty index

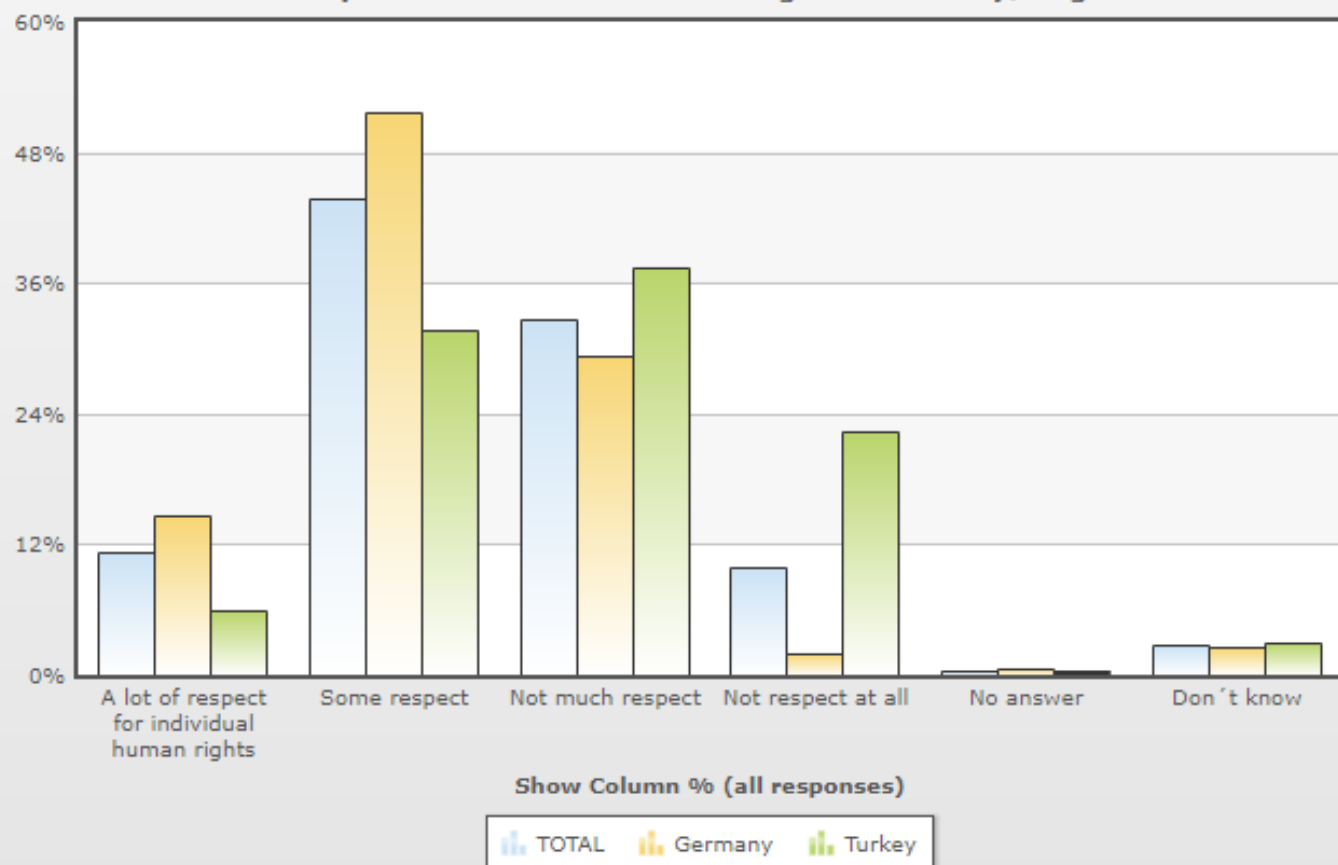


## Educational equality
