What is Anywhere Article?

Anywhere Article is focused on making journal content on Wiley Online Library more readable and portable, whilst also allowing rich information to be brought to the surface. It achieves these goals in the following ways:

READABILITY. Clean design. Superfluous information and unnecessary distractions have been removed so that readers can focus on the article. Figures can be viewed in context or separately, and easily navigated, browsed or downloaded.

FUNCTIONALITY. The new layout and sidebar tray allow access to important information, i.e. references, figures, publication history at any point in the reading experience, without losing their place on the main page.

MOBILITY. Whatever device you use - desktop, tablet, or mobile - the article will be presented to take best advantage of that device, always readable, always easy to use, wherever you are.

Articles and Chapters

Journal articles and book chapters have similar layout and tool functionality.

1. This menu provides quick access to journal/book tools.
2. Access publication homepage for more details on journal, book or reference work.
3. Browse Issues, Articles, Chapters, Table of Contents.
4. Subscribe or renew access.
5. Author, journal or book information, and special features section (if applicable).
6. Link returns you to Volume/Issue or Table of Contents page.
7. Expand to view citation, author, publication and funding information.
8. Access icon indicates whether you have access to the full text of the article or chapter.
9. Search within Publication.
10. Article or chapter tools.
11. View abstract/summary, full text, figures, references, tables, supporting information and citations.
