

## Guide to the BPSA Platform

## 1. Accessing the Hub

After your details have been uploaded onto the BPSA website, you will receive an email from <u>bpsassessment@bps.ac.uk</u> to register and activate your account. If you do not receive this email, please double check you junk mail folder in the first instance, you can resend the registration email to yourself by clicking on the 'Resend registration email' link on our sign in page. If you have any issues, please contact us at <u>bpsassessment@bps.ac.uk</u>.

Please be aware that the URL for the BPSA website is: <u>https://hub.bpsassessment.com</u> Once you have successfully registered, please login by clicking the 'Sign in' button in the top right-hand corner. This will take you to the BPSA home page.

If you forget your password, you can reset it using the 'reset password' link, also found on the sign in page. Please note, you have 5 attempts to enter your password correctly. After the fifth time your account will be locked, please get in touch with your event administrator or the BPSA team at <u>bpsassessment@bps.ac.uk</u> if this happens.
