


Guide to the BPSA Platform

1. Accessing the Hub

After your details have been uploaded onto the BPSA website, you will receive an email from bpsassessment@bps.ac.uk to register and activate your account. If you do not receive this email, please double check you junk mail folder in the first instance, you can resend the registration email to yourself by clicking on the 'Resend registration email' link on our sign in page. If you have any issues, please contact us at bpsassessment@bps.ac.uk.

Please be aware that the URL for the BPSA website is: <https://hub.bpsassessment.com> Once you have successfully registered, please login by clicking the 'Sign in' button in the top right-hand corner. This will take you to the BPSA home page.

If you forget your password, you can reset it using the 'reset password' link, also found on the sign in page. Please note, you have 5 attempts to enter your password correctly. After the fifth time your account will be locked, please get in touch with your event administrator or the BPSA team at bpsassessment@bps.ac.uk if this happens.

2. Navigating your way around


Once you have successfully logged into the website, you will be taken to the hub, which holds all of the information you will need to prepare for your assessments.



Clicking 'Show More' will expand the view to show all the content available. Clicking 'Start' on any of the boxes will take you straight into the resource.

If an assessment is not yet open, there will be no start button. Please contact your school if you're not sure why an assessment is visible but not available to start.

Assessments which have been deactivated or are in the past will show up in the 'Results' tab.

When you've completed your practice assessment, you should be able to view the feedback by exiting the assessment and then clicking 'Results' under the 'Practice Assessments' tab in the assessment interface as displayed above.

If you have been granted access to practice papers, they will be available to you here. These formative assessments are intended to allow you to test your own knowledge and skills related to prescribing and familiarise yourself with the PSA assessment environment.

After you complete these practice assessments, you will be given your total score and the score you achieved in each of the 8 sections of the assessment.

Clicking on 'Results' will give full feedback on your answers, including revealing the optimal answers and the justification for them
