

# Blackboard Learn - Export/Import Course Content


This document describes how to use Export/Import to bring existing course content into your new course.

There are four main sections to this document:

- Export Course Files
- Download the Export File
- Import Course Files
- Export and Import Tests and Pools

Follow these instructions carefully as there are important settings to be aware of. The Export/Import process will not create an exact replica of your course. When you have completed importing your course, you will have to edit some of the content such as course menu and date settings in the destination course.

# **Export Course Files**



### Step 2

In the Export/Archive Course page, choose **Export Package**. The Export Course page appears.





# Step 3

In the Export Course page (see graphic below), consider the following:

- a. This is the ID of the course **from** which you will export content.
- b. Important: Under File Attachments, choose the default options;
  - Copy links and include copies of the files in the course default directory
  - Copy links and include copies of the files outside the course default directory

**Note:** Use the "Calculate Size" option to determine if your export package is below the 500 mb size limit. If the size exceeds 500 mb, then use the "Manage Package Contents", which opens a separate window that allows you to deselect files from the export package.

# Step 4

Under Select Course Materials (below), consider the following:

- a) Choose the course materials that you want to include in the course export package only, **not all**.
- b) IMPORTANT: If Assignments or Test, Surveys and Pools are selected, then also select Grade Center Columns and Settings. Failure to select the Grade Center Columns can result in problems with Assignments in the destination course. It is recommended that the tests, pools and assignments are exported, and imported to the new course separately. Please see the last section of this document.

Note: Existing Student Grades will not be copied.

- c) If you export the Discussion Board, then consider selecting "Include only the forum with no starter posts". This will exclude the first student posts.
- d) The "Settings" checkbox is optional. Be aware that selecting this option can cause duplication of folders and files in the destination course.
- e) The Navigation Settings, under Settings, exports the settings for the course Entry Point as well as, the selected style for the course menu and content menu.

# Step 5

Click **Submit** to export this course with these settings. The Export/Archive Course page displays a "Success" message.



## Step 6

After the selections for Export Course are submitted, the system creates the Export package. A banner message appears indicating the status of the action.

In several minutes, you will receive an automated email from the Blackboard Admin letting you know the Export file is available to download. This email also contains messages regarding problems it encountered exporting any content.

# **Download the Export File**

## Step 1

After you receive the email, you must download the Export file to your local computer. From the source course go to the **Control Panel > Packages and Utilities > Export/Archive Course**. The Export/Archive Course page appears.

## Step 2

In the Export/Archive Course page, click on the Export File link and download the file.

The export file is a "ZIP" file and must be downloaded as a "ZIP" file. **Do not open or change the** contents of this file.

Be careful how you download the "ZIP" file because some processes will change the file extension to "txt" and will not properly import your course content. Each operating system and Internet browser combination will have its own menu list and associated action, although the end result is the same.



Save this Export file making note of the file name and location where you save it.

**Note**: Do not unzip an Export package or remove files from the package, otherwise the package will not import correctly.



# **Import Course Files**



package copies the content of the package into the existing Course. Importing a do not include user enrollments or records, such as discussion board posts and student test or assignment attempts.

Consider the following options in the detailed Import Package page;

- a. This is the ID of the course **to** which you will import content.
- b. Use Choose File to locate and select the Export file (ZIP extension) you downloaded earlier.

c. Click **Submit** to import this course with the selected settings.



#### Select Export to Local Computer.




The download window will differ depending on the browser you are using. Make sure to which folder the zip file has been downloaded to. Usually it is
