ERASMUS+ STUDENT MOBILITY FOR STUDIES APPLICATION GUIDELINE





Erasmus+ Program

Erasmus student mobility is carried out in the framework of prior "inter-institutional agreements" between home and host universities, both of which must be holders of a valid Erasmus University Charter.

This type of mobility enables students at higher education institutions to spend an integrated period of study in another country participating in the program.

Who can apply?

- Undergraduate Program students with a minimum cumulative average of 2.20 over 4.00
- Graduate and Post Graduate Program students with a minimum cumulative average of 2.50 over 4.00

Who can not apply?

- Freshman students studying in associate or undergraduate programs.
- Visiting students (Turkish or international students)
- Associate and Undergraduate Program students who have a cumulative average less than 2.20 over 4.00.
- Graduate and Post Graduate Program students who have a cumulative average less than 2.50 over 4.00.

Duration

- 3 months at least
- 12 months at most

Evaluation Criteria

- 50 % academic success (Cumulative Grade Point Average mentioned in the transcript)
- 50 % foreign language (Score of English Language Proficiency Exam held by School of Foreign Languages of IUE)

Additionally,

- Students with disabilities (if documented): +10
- Children of veterans and martyrs: +10
- Students who took part in Erasmus mobility activities before: -10
- Students who take part in Erasmus mobility in the country of their citizenship: -10
- Students who were nominated and granted before and gave up their mobility: -10

will receive the points declared above.

- The number of the students that will be given Erasmus grant will be determined according to the Erasmus grade on Faculty basis.
- Please consult to the Erasmus Coordinator at your department before deciding on the partner university for your Erasmus studies. You can Access the departmental coordinator list on http://ects.ieu.edu.tr/idari.php?id=29

As the language of instruction in most of the universities is the local language, please make sure that you already know the language of instruction at the partner university.

Documents to be submitted for application

- Erasmus Student Mobility Application Form (Available on http://oia.iue.edu.tr/)
- Transcript (will be requested from Registrar's Office)
- IUE Proficiency in English Exam (PIE) result document (can be obtained from Student Affairs Directorate).
 (Note: The students who have taken the English Proficiency Exam on September 21,2016 do not need to submit this document)

THE FORMS HAVE TO BE FILLED ONLINE. HAND-WRITTEN FORMS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

- The grant allocated is only for support purposes; it does not aim to cover all the expenses made by the beneficiary.
- There will not be a separate payment made from the Erasmus fund for expenses such as the plane tickets, accommodation expenses, health insurance, etc. Such expenses are to be covered by the student.
- 70% of Erasmus grant is paid before the students goes for placement, and the remaining 30% is paid upon returning and completion of the paperwork.
- The higher education institution reserves the right to not to pay the remaining payment in part or in full, or ask for a reimbursement of an already paid amount for students who fail to fulfill their responsibilities on purpose and participate in the program at the host institution.
- Students selected for the program may benefit from the placement program without any grant if they wish to.
