Medical Insurance

It is mandatory that all participants should purchase traveler's insurance covering the entire program perid.

Certificate of Completion

A certificate of completion will be given to students who complete the whole program faithfully.

Your academic performance is assessed according to assignments, attendance and classroom participation. For participants, over 80% of class attendance is required to get the certificate along with 3 credits.

Arrival

Please make sure that you arrive in Korea(Incheon International Airport) on July 31st, 2017. Please be sure to select a flight that arrives in Korea no later than 1 p.m., due to pick-up and check-in arrangements. KOREATECH will provide 'group transportation' from Incheon International Airport to the KOREATECH without charge on July 31st. Transportation to Incheon International Airport will be provided on dparture date. Please be sure to select a flight that depart Korea no later than 1:00 p.m on August 18th, 2017.

All participants should inform us of your flight schedule right after it has been booked.

Accommodations

Student dormitory is available to Summer school pro-gram praticipatns. Dorm rooms are western-style with twin beds, desks, bookshelves, closets, shower booth and toilet. You have to buy a blanket and pillow on the arrival day. Every room is equipped with LAN connections. If you bring your own laptop computer, you can use WiFi for free.

Visa

In case of participants from countries with visa exemption agreements with Republic of Korea, no VISA will be required for the program for up to three months. However, participants form the countries with no visa exemption, need to submit the letter of invitation(we will send you after evaluation) along with other required documents to Korean consulate or embassy in their respective countries in order to obtain a C-3 visa.
