

Call for Applications MSc Economics of the Middle East (EMEA)

Programme Start: October 2017

Application Period: 1 April – 15 July 2017

The School of Business and Economics and the Center for Near and Middle Eastern Studies (CNMS) of Philipps-Universität Marburg are pleased to announce the acceptance of applications for the EMEA programme.

EMEA is a unique master's programme combining institutional economics and business administration with applications to the economies of the MENA region. The curriculum equips students with knowledge about up-to-date issues relevant for MENA countries, e.g., Islamic finance, political economy, natural resources, corruption, and conflict. Additionally, three possible specialisation tracks allow students to sharpen their profile towards a career as regional experts with modern problem-solving skills specific to economics, finance and accounting, or management.

Admission Requirements

A bachelor's degree (or equivalent) in theoretical or business economics is required. Applicants must have completed 72 ECTS in economics or business courses: From the mentioned 72 ECTS, 18 ECTS have to cover theoretical economics (e.g., microeconomics, macroeconomics, public finance) and 12 ECTS have to cover methods (e.g., mathematics, statistics). Furthermore, proof of English language proficiency at C1 Level CEFR is a requirement.

Application

Applications must be submitted between 1 April 2017 and 15 July 2017. A selection committee will carefully review the application and shortlisted candidates will be invited to a phone interview. A preliminary decision will be issued within two weeks after the phone interview with formal letters being sent within a few weeks after the phone interview.
