ERASMUS+ Program

ERASMUS+ student mobility is carried out in the framework of prior "inter-institutional agreements" between home and host universities, both of which must be holders of a valid ERASMUS+ University Charter.

This type of mobility enables students at higher education institutions to spend an integrated period of study in another country participating in the program.

Who can apply?

- Associate/Undergraduate Program students with a minimum cumulative average of 2.20 over 4.00
- Graduate and Post Graduate Program students with a minimum cumulative average of 2.50 over 4.00

Who can not apply?

- Freshman students studying in associate or undergraduate programs.
- Visiting students (Turkish and international students)
- Students who have not renewed registration or who are on leave of absence
- Associate and Undergraduate Program students who have a cumulative average less than 2.20 over 4.00.
- Graduate and Post Graduate Program students who have a cumulative average less than 2.50 over 4.00.

Duration

- 3 months at least
- 12 months at most

Evaluation Criteria

- 50 % academic success (Cumulative Grade Point Average mentioned in the transcript)
- 50 % foreign language (Score of English Language Proficiency Exam held by School of Foreign Languages of IUE)

Additionally,

- Students with disabilities (if documented): +10
- Children of veterans and martyrs: +15
- Students who took part in ERASMUS+ mobility activities before: -10
- Students who take part in ERASMUS+ mobility in the country of their citizenship: -10
- Students who were nominated before and gave up their mobility after the withdrawal deadline: -10 will receive the points declared above.

Special issues to focus on before the application

- The number of the students that will be given ERASMUS+ grant will be determined according to the ERASMUS+ grade on Faculty basis.
- Please consult to the ERASMUS+ Coordinator at your department before deciding on the partner university for your ERASMUS+ studies. You can Access the departmental coordinator list on http://ects.ieu.edu.tr/idari.php?id=29
- As the language of instruction in most of the universities is the local language, please make sure that you already know the **language of instruction** at the partner university.
- Students participating in Erasmus+ student mobility program are required to take at least 30 ECTS credits per semester. Based on the academic program of the partner university abroad, total number of ECTS credits per semester can be 33 the most, and 27 the least.
- Students going abroad with Erasmus+ program need to pay their tuition fees for the respective semester to IUE by the deadline of payment indicated on the academic calendar. They do not need to make a separate payment to the partner university abroad. However, they are responsible for all costs such as accommodation, transportation, personal expenses, dining, health insurance, etc.

- Students studying in a double major may apply for mobility for only one major during the same application period.
- According to the flow of the pandemic and partner country's regulations, it is possible that the Mobility is started as physical but later converted in to a virtual Mobility.

According to this;

The late registration in to IUE will be offered to the student who has to come back to Turkey and student can continue his/her education in IUE.

It is possible for a student to come back to Turkey and keep continuing partner university's offered online education from Turkey due to the pandemic.

The student has to decide if she/he will be registering to the online courses in IUE or continue online education which partner university offered and complete the semester accordingly.

If the offered online courses by both partner university and IUE does not include all classes written on the Learning Agreement, the student may need to benefit from both partner university's and IUE's online classes in order to study all of his/her courses on the Learning Agreement.

In the fame of these points, students who would like to participate in Erasmus Student Mobility,

According to the flow of the pandemic, if the partner university closes the academic period or switches to online education, there may be problems in education

It may not be possible to register in to IUE's courses for the semester even though the partner university offers online education.

In the frame of pandemic, some financial obligations may occur due to, not to be able to enter-leave the country, visa issues, accommodation situations etc.

During the period of study at the partner university in the pandemic period, if any health problems are encountered, the health insurance to be used should cover the "pandemic"

There will be no financial support offered except for the Erasmus grant.

Student accepts that Erasmus grant payments and other academic transactions will be made within the scope of the "Erasmus and other international exchange programs directive" and the "Erasmus Grant Agreement" which is signed by the participant.

• The grant allocated is only for support purposes; it does not aim to cover all the expenses made by the beneficiary.

- There will not be a separate payment made from the ERASMUS+ fund for expenses such as the plane tickets, accommodation expenses, health insurance, etc. Such expenses are to be covered by the student.
- 70% of ERASMUS+ grant is paid before the students go for mobility for studies, and the remaining 30% is paid upon returning and completion of the paperwork.
- The higher education institution reserves the right to not to pay the remaining grant in part or in full, or ask for a reimbursement of an already paid amount for students who fail to fulfill their responsibilities on purpose and participate in the program at the host institution.
- Students, who fail 2/3 of total credits of the courses they took at partner university abroad, are not paid the remaining amount of the grant. Students may be asked for refund based on the final calculations if they have to.
- In addition to the monthly grants mentioned in Table-2 for the economically possible restrictions for the students whose parents or their dependents are subscribed to under the Social Assistance and Solidarity Law No. 3294 dated 29.05.1989 under the Article 2 of the Law on Encouragement of Social Assistance and Solidarity, 100 € extra grant can be paid. In order for the selected students to benefit from the additional grant, they must apply to the International Relations Office and deliver the document that they receive a pension in need under the aforementioned Law from their Provincial Directorate of Family, Labor and Social Services.

IMPORTANT: The number of students who will be given Erasmus grant will be determined according to the amount of Erasmus grant that will be allocated to IUE by Turkish National Agency. There will be another announcement regarding grant allocation to participants.

APPLICATION PROCESS

The students will be able to submit their 2021-2022 academic year FALL semester ERASMUS+ Student Mobility Applications on OASIS as of March 1, 2021. Students may change their applications on OASIS until 22 of March, 2021 on 03:00 P.M.

The applications will be evaluated according to the latest/most recent university choices. In order for the applications to be valid, the printed out and signed application form has to be sent to the Office of International Affairs' mail address, oia@ieu.edu.tr until 22, March, 2021 on 05:00 P.M.

Applications made only through OASIS will not be taken into consideration without submitting a signed application form to the Office of International Affairs.
